SENATE ENROLLED ACT No. 36

AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning professions and occupations.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

SECTION 1. IC 25-21.5-1-3.2 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE AS A **NEW** SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2024]: Sec. 3.2. "Boundary marker" means a symbol, sign, or object placed by a:

(1) professional surveyor; or

(2) person acting under the direct supervision of a professional surveyor;

for the purpose of demarking any point, course, or line in the boundary of a tract of land.

SECTION 2. IC 25-21.5-1-6.7 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE AS A **NEW** SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2024]: Sec. 6.7. "Person" means the following:

(1) An entity.

(2) A corporation.

(3) An individual.

(4) A limited liability company.

(5) A partnership.

SECTION 3. IC 25-21.5-13-1.5 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE AS A **NEW** SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2024]: **Sec. 1.5. (a) A person, not having an**

ownership interest in land, who knowingly or intentionally disturbs or removes a boundary marker on the tract of land commits a Class C infraction.

(b) In addition to the judgment awarded under IC 34-28-5-4, the court may order a person who violates subsection (a) to pay to the landowner the cost of reestablishing the boundary marker.
