**Synopsis:** Electronic health data work group. Requires the state department of health and the office of the secretary of family and social services to establish a work group to study specified issues concerning access to electronic health information. (The introduced version of this bill was prepared by the health finance commission.)

Effective: Upon passage.

16	any recommendation.
17	(d) This SECTION expires December 31, 2014.



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SECTION 2. An emergency is declared for this act.
