SENATE BILL No. 54

A BILL FOR AN ACT concerning pensions.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

SECTION 1. [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2014] (a) As used in this SECTION, "commission" refers to the pension management oversight commission established by IC 2-5-12-1.

(b) The general assembly urges the legislative council to assign to the commission or another appropriate committee the task of studying the status of existing local government unit pension plans, including the participation of local government units in the public employees' retirement fund, to determine whether changes are necessary or advisable.

(c) If the commission or another appropriate committee is assigned the topic described in subsection (b), the commission or committee shall issue to the legislative council a final report containing the commission's or committee's findings and recommendations, including any recommended legislation concerning the topic, in an electronic format under IC 5-14-6 not later than November 1, 2014.
