DIGEST OF SB 55 (Updated February 12, 2015 3:34 pm - DI 106)

Citations Affected: IC 34-18.

Synopsis: Medical malpractice actions. Permits a patient to bring an action against a health care provider without submitting the complaint to the medical review board if: (1) the amount of the claim is not more than \$15,000; (2) the cause of action is based on the removal of the wrong body part; or (3) the cause of action is based on the existence of a foreign object in the patient's body.

Effective: July 1, 2015.

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning civil procedure.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

1 SECTION 1. IC 34-18-8-6 IS AMENDED TO READ AS
2 FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2015]: Sec. 6. (a) Notwithstanding
3 section 4 of this chapter, a patient may commence an action against a
4 health care provider for malpractice without submitting a proposed
5 complaint to a medical review panel if the patient's pleadings include
6 a declaration that:

- 7 (1) the patient seeks damages from the health care provider in an
8 amount not greater than fifteen thousand dollars (\$15,000);
9 (2) **the patient's cause of action is based on the removal of the**
10 **wrong body part; or**
11 (3) **the patient's cause of action is based on the existence of a**
12 **foreign object in the patient's body that has no therapeutic or**
13 **diagnostic purpose.**

14 In an action commenced under this subsection (or IC 27-12-8-6(a)
15 before its repeal), the patient is barred from recovering any amount
16 greater than fifteen thousand dollars (\$15,000) ~~except as provided in~~

1 ~~subsection (b):~~ **except for causes of action based on a declaration**

4 (b) A patient who:

- 5 (1) commences an action under ~~subsection (a)~~ **subsection (a)(1)**
 6 (or IC 27-12-8-6(a) before its repeal) in the reasonable belief that
 7 damages in an amount not greater than fifteen thousand dollars
 8 (\$15,000) are adequate compensation for the bodily injury
 9 allegedly caused by the health care provider's malpractice; and
 10 (2) later learns, during the pendency of the action, that the bodily
 11 injury is more serious than previously believed and that fifteen
 12 thousand dollars (\$15,000) is insufficient compensation for the
 13 bodily injury;

14 may move that the action be dismissed without prejudice and, upon
 15 dismissal of the action, may file a proposed complaint subject to
 16 section 4 of this chapter based upon the same allegations of malpractice
 17 as were asserted in the action dismissed under this subsection. In a
 18 second action commenced in court following the medical review
 19 panel's proceeding on the proposed complaint, the patient may recover
 20 an amount greater than fifteen thousand dollars (\$15,000). However,
 21 a patient may move for dismissal without prejudice and, if dismissal
 22 without prejudice is granted, may commence a second action under this
 23 subsection only if the patient's motion for dismissal is filed within two
 24 (2) years after commencement of the original action under subsection
 25 ~~(a)~~ **(a)(1)** (or IC 27-12-8-6(a) before its repeal).

Madam President: I move that Senate Bill 55 be amended to read as follows:

Page 1, between the enacting clause and line 1, begin a new paragraph and insert:

"SECTION 1. IC 27-1-3-32 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE AS A **NEW SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS** [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2015]: **Sec. 32. (a) The department shall calculate the direct file threshold amount, as described in IC 34-18-8-0.5 (medical malpractice).**

(b) The department shall publish in the Indiana Register the direct file threshold amount determined under IC 34-18-8-0.5.

SECTION 2. IC 34-18-8-0.5. IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE AS A NEW SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2015]: **Sec. 0.5. (a) The direct file threshold amount used for purposes of section 6(a), 6(b), and 6(c) of this chapter is equal to the following.**

(1) Before July 1, 2020, forty-five thousand dollars (\$45,000).

(2) After June 30, 2020, the amount determined by the department of insurance under subsection (b).

(b) On July 1, 2020, and on July 1 of every fifth year thereafter, the department of insurance shall determine a new threshold amount to be used for purposes of section 6(a), 6(b), and 6(c) of this chapter. The new threshold amount is equal to the amount determined in the following STEPS:

STEP ONE: Determine the result of:

(A) the Consumer Price Index for All Urban Consumers (CPI-U) determined by the Bureau of Labor Statistics of the United States Department of Labor, as of December 31 of the most recently completed calendar year; divided by

(B) the Consumer Price Index for All Urban Consumers (CPI-U) determined by the Bureau of Labor Statistics of the United States Department of Labor, as of:

(i) December 31, 2014, in the case of the determination of a new threshold amount made for July 1, 2020; or

(ii) December 31 of the year preceding the year in which a new threshold amount was last determined under this section, in the case of the determination of a new threshold amount made for July 1, 2025, or thereafter.

STEP TWO: Determine the result of:

(A) the index of the Medical Care component of the Consumer Price Index for All Urban Consumers (CPI-U) determined by the Bureau of Labor Statistics of the United States Department of Labor, as of December 31 of the most recently completed calendar year; divided by

(B) the index of the Medical Care component of the Consumer Price Index for All Urban Consumers (CPI-U) determined by the Bureau of Labor Statistics of the United States Department of Labor, as of:

(i) December 31, 2014, in the case of the determination of a new threshold amount made for July 1, 2020; or

(ii) December 31 of the year preceding the year in which a new threshold amount was last determined under this section, in the case of the determination of a new threshold



amount made for July 1, 2025, or thereafter.

STEP THREE: Determine the result of:

(A) the sum of the STEP ONE and STEP TWO results; divided by

(B) two (2).

STEP FOUR: Multiply the STEP THREE result by the current threshold amount."
