5	(1) attend the same high school; and
6	(2) are first considered to have entered grade 9 in the same year
7	(b) The term does not include an individual entering grade 9
8	who is:
9	(1) pursuing a certificate of completion under an
10	individualized education program established under IC 20-35
11	and
12	(2) ineligible to graduate as determined by a case conference
13	committee.
