Citations Affected: IC 20-30-6-18.

Synopsis: School fitness and wellness classes. Provides that a school corporation may enter into a contract with a person to provide "pass/fail" classes to high school students concerning personal wellness and fitness. Provides that a class instructor is not required to be licensed as a teacher and is subject to an expanded criminal history check.
