DIGEST OF SB 72 (Updated February 12, 2015 1:40 pm - DI 55)

Citations Affected: Noncode.

Synopsis: Motor vehicle manufacturer sales. Urges the legislative council to assign to the appropriate study committee for the 2015 interim the task of studying the sale by a motor vehicle manufacturer of new motor vehicles directly to consumers other than through an independent franchised new motor vehicle dealer that has a physical place of business capable of performing complete warranty service on motor vehicles produced by the manufacturer.

Effective: Upon passage.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

7 (d) **The general assembly urges the legislative council to assign**
8 **to the appropriate study committee for the 2015 interim the task**
9 **of studying the sale by a motor vehicle manufacturer of new motor**
10 **vehicles directly to consumers other than through an independent**
11 **franchised new motor vehicle dealer that has a physical place of**
12 **business capable of performing complete warranty service on**
13 **motor vehicles produced by the manufacturer.**
14 (e) **If the topic set forth in subsection (d) is assigned to a study**
15 **committee, the study committee shall issue to the legislative council**
16 **a final report containing the study committee's findings and**

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1 **recommendations, including any recommended legislation**
2 **concerning the topic, in an electronic format under IC 5-14-6 not**
3 **later than November 1, 2015.**
4 **(f) This SECTION expires December 31, 2015.**
5 **SECTION 2. An emergency is declared for this act.**
