DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: IC 9-21-8-5.5.

Synopsis: Safe distance for vehicles overtaking bicycles. Requires the driver of a vehicle, when passing a bicycle that is proceeding in the same direction as the vehicle, to maintain a safe distance of at least three feet between the vehicle and the bicycle. (A violation of this requirement is a Class C infraction under IC 9-21-8-49.).

SENATE BILL No. 72

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning motor vehicles.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

1	SECTION 1. IC 9-21-8-5.5 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE
2	AS A NEW SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY
3	1, 2018]: Sec. 5.5. When a vehicle passes a bicycle that is
4	proceeding in the same direction as the vehicle, the driver of the
5	vehicle must maintain a safe distance of at least three (3) feet
6	between the vehicle and the bicycle during the entire time that the
7	vehicle is passing the bicycle.
