

## **SENATE BILL No. 88**

DIGEST OF SB 88 (Updated February 8, 2017 4:28 pm - DI 110)

Citations Affected: IC 20-30.

**Synopsis:** School calendar. Prohibits public schools and accredited nonpublic schools from beginning student instructional days for the school year before the last Monday in August, beginning with the 2018-2019 school year.

Effective: July 1, 2018.

## SENATE BILL No. 88

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning education.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

	SECTION 1. IC 20-30-2-9 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE
2	AS A <b>NEW</b> SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY
3	1, 2018]: Sec. 9. (a) This section does not affect a collective
1	bargaining agreement between a school employer (as defined in
5	IC 20-29-2-15) and an exclusive representative that is entered into
6	or renewed before July 1, 2018.

- (b) This section does not affect a contract entered into or renewed by a governing body before July 1, 2018.
- (c) Beginning with the 2018-2019 school year, the student instructional days that make up a school year may not begin before the last Monday in August.

Replace the effective date in SECTION 1 with "[EFFECTIVE JULY 1,2018]".

Page 1, line 3, delete "applies only to" and insert "does not affect".

Page 1, line 5, after "into" insert "or renewed before July 1, 2018.".

Page 1, delete line 6.

Page 1, line 7, delete "applies only to" and insert "does not affect".

Page 1, line 8, delete "after June 30, 2017." and insert "**before July 1, 2018.**".

Page 1, line 9, delete "2017-2018" and insert "2018-2019".

Page 1, line 11, delete "fourth" insert "last".
