DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: IC 20-24-3-2.5.

Synopsis: Charter school organizer contracts. Prohibits a charter school organizer from entering into contracts under which an officer or employee of the organizer or a relative of an officer or employee of the organizer will receive compensation or proceeds. Provides an exception for contracts of \$1,000 or less.

Effective: July 1, 2020.

SENATE BILL No. 88

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning education.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

SECTION 1. IC 20-24-3-2.5, AS AMENDED BY P.L.250-2017
SECTION 10, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
JULY 1, 2020]: Sec. 2.5. (a) If a proposed charter school intends to
contract with an education service provider for substantial educationa
services, management services, or both educational services and
management services, the request for proposals shall require th
applicants to provide the following:
(1) Evidence of the education service provider's success i
serving student populations similar to the targeted populations
including demonstrated academic achievement as well a
successful management of nonacademic school functions, is
applicable.
(2) A term sheet setting forth:
(A) the proposed duration of the service contract;
(B) the roles and responsibilities of the organizer, the school
staff, and the education service provider;
(C) the performance evaluation measures and timelines;



1	(D) the compensation structure, including clear identification
2	of all fees to be paid to the education service provider;
3	(E) the methods of contract oversight and enforcement;
4	(F) the investment disclosure;
5	(G) that the school and the authorizer are entitled to any data
6	directly related to the operation or management of the school,
7	such as financial data, enrollment data, demographic data,
8	performance data, and student data, in the possession of the
9	education service provider, but may not include any
10	proprietary, intellectual property, or similarly protected data of
11	the education service provider; and
12	(H) the conditions for renewal and termination of the contract.
13	(3) A disclosure statement to explain any existing or potential
14	conflicts of interest between the organizer and the proposed
15	education service provider or any affiliated business entities.
16	(4) Assurance that the organizer will be structurally independent
17	of the education service provider and shall set and approve school
18	policies. The assurance must also provide that the terms of the
19	service contract must be reached by the organizer and the
20	education service provider through arms length negotiations in
21	which the organizer must be represented by legal counsel. The
22	legal counsel may not also represent the education service
23	provider.
24	(b) Other than de minimis contracts valued at one thousand
25	dollars (\$1,000) or less, an organizer may not enter into any
26	contracts with a person (as defined in IC 2-2.2-1-14) from which an
27	officer or employee of the organizer or a relative (as defined in
28	IC 2-2.2-1-17) of an officer or employee of the organizer will

receive compensation under or proceeds of the contract.
