A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning education.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

1	SECTION 1. IC 20-26-12-23, AS AMENDED BY P.L.233-2015,
2	SECTION 172, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS
3	[EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2016]: Sec. 23. A school corporation may:
4	(1) borrow money to buy curricular materials; and
5	(2) issue notes, maturing serially in not more than three (3) four
6	(4) years and payable from its general fund, to secure the loan.
