

SENATE BILL No. 113

DIGEST OF SB 113 (Updated January 14, 2019 11:31 am - DI 133)

Citations Affected: IC 12-7; IC 12-15.

Synopsis: Guardian reimbursement and Medicaid eligibility. Specifies that an amount not to exceed \$175 a month in court ordered guardianship fees for an individual who is: (1) in an institution; or (2) applying for or participating in the Medicaid aged and disabled waiver; is exempt from Medicaid income eligibility consideration.

Effective: July 1, 2019.

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning human services.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

1	SECTION 1. IC 12-7-2-118.8 IS AMENDED TO READ AS
2	FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2019]: Sec. 118.8. "Institution", for
3	purposes of:
4	(1) IC 12-10-11.5, has the meaning set forth in IC 12-10-11.5-1;

6	(2) IC 12-15-7-2, has the meaning set forth in IC 12-15-7-2(b).
7	SECTION 2. IC 12-15-7-2 IS AMENDED TO READ AS
8	FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2019]: Sec. 2. (a) Fifty-two dollars
9	(\$52) monthly may be exempt from income eligibility consideration.
0	(b) This subsection applies to an individual who is in an
1	institution or applying for or participating in the Medicaid aged
2	and disabled waiver. As used in this subsection, "institution" refers
3	to any of the following:
4	(1) A state institution.
5	(2) A health facility licensed under IC 16-28.
6	(3) A hospital licensed under IC 16-21-2.
7	(4) An intermediate care facility for individuals with

2	In addition to the amount specified in subsection (a), an amount in
3	court ordered guardianship fees not to exceed one hundred
1	seventy-five dollars (\$175) monthly is exempt from income
5	eligibility consideration. The office shall seek any approval
6	necessary from the United States Department of Health and
7	Human Services to implement this subsection.
