## **SENATE BILL No. 114**

DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: IC 20-33-2-17.7.

**Synopsis:** Excused absences from school for state fair activities. Provides that the governing body of a school corporation or the chief administrative officer of a nonpublic school system shall authorize, for not more than three instructional days in a school year, the absence and excuse of each school student who participates in the state fair. Provides that an excused absence to participate in the state fair may not be used in calculations to assess a school's improvement.

Effective: July 1, 2014.

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning education.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

13	improvement under IC 20-31-8.
