

SENATE BILL No. 114

DIGEST OF SB 114 (Updated January 22, 2014 2:23 pm - DI 116)

Citations Affected: IC 20-33.

Synopsis: Excused absences from school for state fair activities. Provides that the governing body of a school corporation or the chief administrative officer of a nonpublic school system shall authorize, for not more than three instructional days in a school year, the absence and excuse of each school student who participates or exhibits in an approved activity in the state fair. Provides that an excused absence to participate in the state fair may not be used in calculations to assess a school's improvement.

Effective: July 1, 2014.

Leising

January 8, 2014, read first time and referred to Committee on Education and Career Development.
