

### **ENGROSSED** SENATE BILL No. 114

DIGEST OF SB 114 (Updated February 11, 2014 10:40 am - DI 71)

Citations Affected: IC 20-33.

Synopsis: Excused absences from school for state fair activities. Provides that the governing body of a school corporation or the chief administrative officer of a nonpublic school system shall authorize, for not more than five instructional days in a school year, the absence and excuse of each school student if the student or a member of the student's household participates or exhibits in the state fair.

Effective: July 1, 2014.

#### COMMITTEE REPORT

Mr. Speaker: Your Committee on Education, to which was referred Senate Bill 114, has had the same under consideration and begs leave to report the same back to the House with the recommendation that said bill be amended as follows:

Page 1, line 3, delete "The" and insert "Except as provided in subsection (b), the".

Page 1, line 5, delete "authorize, for not more than three" and insert "authorize the absence and excuse of each school student if the student or a member of the student's household participates or exhibits in the Indiana state fair for educational purposes, as evidenced in writing by the student's parent. The number of excused absences a student may receive under this section may not exceed five (5) instructional days in a school year. A student excused from school attendance under this section may not be recorded as being absent on any date for which the excuse is operative and may not be penalized by the school in any manner.

(b) In order for a student to receive an excused absence under subsection (a), the student must be in good academic standing, as
