DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: Noncode.

**Synopsis:** School City of East Chicago loan. Transfers, not later than July 1, 2018, to the school disaster loan fund from the state general fund an amount sufficient to pay off the loan that was made to the School City of East Chicago school corporation from the school disaster loan fund.

Effective: Upon passage.

### **SENATE BILL No. 118**

A BILL FOR AN ACT concerning education.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

SECTION 1. [EFFECTIVE UPON PASSAGE] (a) As used in this
 SECTION, the "school disaster loan fund" refers to the school
 disaster loan fund described in IC 20-49-2-11.
 (b) There is transferred to the school disaster loan fund from
 the state general fund not later than July 1, 2018, an amount

sufficient to pay off the loan that was made to the School City of East Chicago school corporation from the school disaster loan fund for the construction, remodel, and repair of a former middle school. On the date of the transfer, the loan is considered paid.

10 (c) The advance agreement between the state board of education
11 and the School City of East Chicago for the loan described in
12 subsection (b) is fulfilled on the date the loan is paid off under
13 subsection (b).

- 14 (d) This SECTION expires July 1, 2019.
- 15 SECTION 2. An emergency is declared for this act.
