

SENATE BILL No. 127

DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: Noncode.

Synopsis: Study of low-carbon and green industries. Requires the Indiana University Paul H. O'Neill School of Public and Environmental Affairs to: (1) assess the potential for the development of low-carbon and green industries in Indiana and the job creation, economic growth, and wealth generation that could result for Indiana communities from the development of these industries; and (2) report the results of its assessment to the legislative council in an electronic format not later than December 1, 2022.

Effective: Upon passage.

A BILL FOR AN ACT concerning economic development.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

1 SECTION 1. [EFFECTIVE UPON PASSAGE] **(a) The Indiana**
2 **University Paul H. O'Neill School of Public and Environmental**
3 **Affairs shall:**
4 **(1) assess:**
5 **(A) the potential for the development of low-carbon and**
6 **green industries in Indiana; and**
7 **(B) the job creation, economic growth, and wealth**
8 **generation that could result for Indiana communities from**
9 **the development of low-carbon and green industries; and**
10 **(2) not later than December 1, 2022, deliver to the executive**
11 **director of the legislative services agency in an electronic**
12 **format under IC 5-14-6 for presentation to the legislative**
13 **council a report setting forth the results of the assessment**
14 **required by subdivision (1).**
15 **(b) This SECTION expires December 31, 2022.**
16 **SECTION 2. An emergency is declared for this act.**
