Synopsis: School calendar. Prohibits public schools and accredited nonpublic schools from beginning student instructional days for the school year before the last Monday in August, beginning with the 2020-2021 school year.

- (c) Beginning with the 2020-2021 school year, the student instructional days that make up a school year may not begin before the last Monday in August.
