DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: IC 20-26-14-8; IC 20-27-8-4.

Synopsis: Physical examinations by nurse practitioners. Provides that a school corporation may participate in an interscholastic athletics association only if the association provides that, if the association requires a student to obtain a physical examination to participate in an athletic event, the physical evaluation may be administered by either a physician or an advanced practice nurse. Provides that the physical examination requirement for a school bus driver may be conducted by an advanced practice nurse.

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning education.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:
