

First Regular Session of the 122nd General Assembly (2021)

PRINTING CODE. Amendments: Whenever an existing statute (or a section of the Indiana Constitution) is being amended, the text of the existing provision will appear in this style type, additions will appear in **this style type**, and deletions will appear in ~~this style type~~.

Additions: Whenever a new statutory provision is being enacted (or a new constitutional provision adopted), the text of the new provision will appear in **this style type**. Also, the word **NEW** will appear in that style type in the introductory clause of each SECTION that adds a new provision to the Indiana Code or the Indiana Constitution.

Conflict reconciliation: Text in a statute in *this style type* or ~~this style type~~ reconciles conflicts between statutes enacted by the 2020 Regular Session of the General Assembly.

SENATE ENROLLED ACT No. 152

AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning courts and court officers.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

SECTION 1. IC 33-33-18-2, AS AMENDED BY P.L.138-2020, SECTION 17, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2021]: Sec. 2. (a) The Delaware circuit court is a court of general jurisdiction with ~~six (6)~~ **five (5)** judges. The divisions of the court shall be known as Delaware circuit court No. 1, No. 2, No. 3, No. 4, **and** No. 5. ~~and No. 6~~. The county of Delaware constitutes the judicial district of the court and each of the court's divisions. The court shall maintain the following dockets:

- (1) Small claims.
- (2) Minor offenses and violations.
- (3) Criminal.
- (4) Juvenile.
- (5) Civil.
- (6) Probate.

(b) The assignment of judges of the court to the dockets specified in subsection (a) shall be by rule of the court.

SECTION 2. IC 33-33-18-2.1 IS REPEALED [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2021]. ~~Sec. 2.1. (a) Notwithstanding section 2 of this chapter, Delaware circuit court No. 6 is established January 1, 2023.~~
