

## **SENATE BILL No. 170**

DIGEST OF SB 170 (Updated January 14, 2019 11:32 am - DI 133)

Citations Affected: IC 31-25.

**Synopsis:** Child fatality report information. Specifies that the report concerning child fatalities in Indiana must include information concerning whether the death occurred: (1) while the child was placed in foster care; or (2) after the child, who was once placed in foster care, was returned to a natural parent.

Effective: July 1, 2019.

## **SENATE BILL No. 170**

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning family law and juvenile law.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

1	SECTION 1. IC 31-25-2-24, AS ADDED BY P.L.119-2013,
2	SECTION 9, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
3	JULY 1, 2019]: Sec. 24. (a) The department shall annually prepare a
4	report concerning all child fatalities in Indiana that are the result of
5	child abuse or neglect. The report must include the following
6	information:
7	(1) A summary of the information gathered concerning child
8	fatalities resulting from abuse or neglect.
9	(2) Demographic information regarding victims, perpetrators, and
0	households involved in child fatalities resulting from abuse or
1	neglect.
2	(3) An analysis of the primary risk factors involved in child
3	fatalities resulting from abuse or neglect.
4	(4) A summary of the most frequent causes of child fatalities
5	resulting from abuse or neglect.
6	(5) A description of the manner in which the information was
7	assembled.



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1	The department shall post the report prepared under this section on the
2	department's Internet web site.
3	(b) As part of the summary of information described in
4	subsection (a)(1), the report must include whether the death
5	occurred in either of the following settings:
6	(1) While the child was placed in foster care.
7	(2) After the child, who was once placed in foster care, was
8	returned to a natural parent.
