A BILL FOR AN ACT concerning professions and occupations.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

9	healing, and the practice of the material sciences of healing.
10	(b) The legislative council is urged to assign to an interim study
11	committee the task of studying the following:
12	(1) The function that individuals who practice naturopathic
13	medicine have in the delivery of health services.
14	(2) The need to create a license for individuals who practice
15	naturopathic medicine.
16	(c) This SECTION expires January 1, 2019.
17	SECTION 2. An emergency is declared for this act.
