# **SENATE BILL No. 176**

DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: IC 16-18-2-221.5; IC 16-42-6.5.

**Synopsis:** Poultry product and rabbit meat labeling. Establishes labeling requirements for poultry products and rabbit meat: (1) for 1,000 poultry or fewer poultry operations and farm slaughtered rabbits; and (2) sold by a person who has not met the antemortem inspection, postmortem inspection, and other inspection requirements.

Effective: Upon passage.

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January 5, 2016, read first time and referred to Committee on Commerce & Technology.



## Introduced

#### Second Regular Session 119th General Assembly (2016)

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning health.

## Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

1	SECTION 1. IC 16-18-2-221.5 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA
2	CODE AS A NEW SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS
3	[EFFECTIVE UPON PASSAGE]: Sec. 221.5. "Meat or poultry
4	products", for purposes of IC 16-42-6.5, has the meaning set forth
5	in IC 16-42-6.5-2.
6	SECTION 2. IC 16-42-6.5 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE
7	AS A NEW CHAPTER TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
8	UPON PASSAGE]:
9	Chapter 6.5. Labeling of Uninspected Meat and Poultry
10	Sec. 1. This chapter applies to a person who raises and
11	slaughters:
12	(1) not more than one thousand (1,000) poultry during the
13	calendar year under an exemption under IC 15-17-5-11 and
14	21 U.S.C. 464(c)(4); or
15	(2) rabbits; and
16	the poultry or rabbits have not met the antemortem inspection,
17	postmortem inspection, and other requirements for the operations



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1	of a person under IC 15-17-5.
2	Sec. 2. As used in this chapter, "meat or poultry products"
3	means any of the following:
4	(1) Poultry products (as defined by IC 15-17-2-88).
5	(2) Rabbit meat.
6	Sec. 3. In addition to any state or federal law that applies to the
7	meat and poultry products, a person may not sell meat or poultry
8	products unless the person meets the requirements of this chapter.
9	Sec. 4. (a) Any meat or poultry products sold under this chapter
10	must include a label that contains the following information:
11	(1) The name and address of the producer of the meat or
12	poultry products.
13	(2) The common or usual name of the meat or poultry
14	products.
15	(3) The ingredients of the meat or poultry products, in
16	descending order by predominance by weight.
17	(4) The net weight and volume of the meat or poultry
18	products by standard measure or numerical count.
19	(5) The date on which the meat or poultry products were
20	processed.
21	(6) The following statement in at least 10 point type: "This
22	product is home produced and processed and has NOT been
23	inspected by the Board of Animal Health.".
24	(b) The labeling requirement under subsection (a) is not
25	considered to be complied with unless the information appears on
26	a label:
27	(1) on the outside container or wrapper; or
28	(2) that is easily seen through the outside container or
29	wrapper;
30	containing the meat or poultry products.
31	SECTION 3. An emergency is declared for this act.
