Citations Affected: Noncode.

Synopsis: Home based vendors. Requires that the state department of health, state board of animal health, and state department of agriculture shall, in consultation with industry groups and food safety experts, submit recommendations concerning home based vendors to the general assembly.

Effective: July 1, 2021.

SENATE BILL No. 185

A BILL FOR AN ACT concerning health.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

- 1 SECTION 1. [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2021] (a) Before December
- 2 1, 2021, the state department of health, state board of animal
- 3 health, and state department of agriculture shall, in consultation
- 4 with industry groups and food safety experts, submit
- 5 recommendations concerning home based vendors to the general
- 6 assembly in an electronic format under IC 5-14-6.
- 7 (b) This SECTION expires July 1, 2022.
