

ENGROSSED SENATE BILL No. 193

DIGEST OF SB 193 (Updated March 17, 2015 11:28 am - DI 123)

Citations Affected: IC 5-2.

Synopsis: Northwest Indiana Law Enforcement Academy. Designates the Northwest Indiana Law Enforcement Academy as a criminal justice agency, and specifies that it is a board certified training center. Defines the powers and duties of its board of directors.

Effective: July 1, 2015.

ENGROSSED SENATE BILL No. 193

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning public safety.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

1	SECTION 1. IC 5-2-1-19 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE
2	AS A NEW SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY
3	1, 2015]: Sec. 19. (a) The Northwest Indiana Law Enforcement
4	Academy, including the academy's board of directors, is designated
5	as a criminal justice agency.
6	(b) The Northwest Indiana Law Enforcement Academy is a
7	board certified training center.
8	(c) As a designated criminal justice agency, the board of
9	directors of the Northwest Indiana Law Enforcement Academy:
0	(1) has all the duties and privileges of a police agency;
1	(2) may appoint, through its executive director, police officers
2	for the Northwest Indiana Law Enforcement Academy;
3	(3) shall establish all rules, policies, and procedures
4	concerning the internal organization, duties, and
5	responsibilities of the police agency, to include:
6	(A) prescribing a distinctive uniform; and



1	(B) designating and operating emergency vehicles; and
2	(4) may undertake investigations according to the purposes of
3	this chapter.
