A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning criminal law and procedure.

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:*

1 SECTION 1. IC 35-50-6-3.1, AS AMENDED BY P.L.106-2020,  
2 SECTION 3, AND P.L.142-2020, SECTION 87, IS AMENDED TO  
3 READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2021]: Sec. 3.1. (a) This  
4 section applies to a person who commits an offense after June 30,  
5 2014.

6 (b) A person assigned to Class A earns one (1) day of good time  
7 credit for each day the person is imprisoned for a crime or confined  
8 awaiting trial or sentencing.

9 (c) A person assigned to Class B earns one (1) day of good time  
10 credit for every three (3) days the person is imprisoned for a crime or  
11 confined awaiting trial or sentencing.

12 (d) A person assigned to Class C earns one (1) day of good time  
13 credit for every six (6) days the person is imprisoned for a crime or  
14 confined awaiting trial or sentencing.

15 (e) A person assigned to Class D earns no good time credit.

16 (f) A person assigned to Class P earns one (1) day of good time  
17 credit for ~~every four (4) days~~ **each day** the person serves on pretrial



1 home detention awaiting trial. A person assigned to Class P does not  
2 earn accrued time for time served on pretrial home detention awaiting  
3 trial.
