# **SENATE BILL No. 194**

#### DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: IC 25-1-9-22.

**Synopsis:** Health care professional cultural training. Requires an individual seeking licensure in a health care profession to complete cultural competency training.

Effective: July 1, 2014.

## SENATE BILL No. 194

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning professions and occupations.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

1	SECTION 1. IC 25-1-9-22 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE
2	AS A <b>NEW</b> SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY
3	1, 2014]: Sec. 22. (a) As used in this section, "board" does not
4	include the Indiana board of veterinary medical examiners
5	(IC 25-38.1-2).
6	(b) An individual who seeks a license issued by a board must
7	first complete, before a license may be issued, cultural competency
8	training that includes the following:
9	(1) Awareness of cultural differences and the individual's
10	beliefs and behaviors related to those differences and their
11	effect on patients and other persons.
12	(2) Knowledge of:
13	(A) various cultural groups with whom the individual is
14	likely to work in the individual's profession; and
15	(B) the effects of social and behavioral differences on the
16	health of members of the cultural groups.



1	(3) Skills to modify the individual's behavior to:
2	(A) improve patient understanding of health needs; and
3	(B) accommodate cultural requirements;
4	to foster patient compliance with wellness and treatment
5	plans.
5	(4) Ability to advocate for the patient in obtaining necessary
7	support to achieve improvement in patient health.
8	(c) This section applies to a new license issued after June 30,
