

SENATE BILL No. 195

DIGEST OF SB 195 (Updated January 11, 2016 1:23 pm - DI 92)

Citations Affected: IC 14-11; IC 14-22; noncode.

Synopsis: Ownership of wild animals. Excludes the wild animal permit from the law requiring notice and hearing on an application for certain permits. Removes language that exempts wild animals that are being held in captivity under a license or permit from being the property of Indiana. Amends the department of natural resource's duties to provide for the protection and proper management of all legally and publicly owned wild animals in Indiana. Provides that the specified fish and wildlife laws do not apply to legally owned captive bred cervidae.

Effective: Upon passage; April 1, 2016.

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning natural and cultural resources.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

10	SECTION 2. IC 14-22-1-1 IS AMENDED TO READ AS
11	FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE UPON PASSAGE]: Sec. 1. (a) All wild
12	animals, except those that are:
13	(1) legally owned or being held in captivity under a license or
14	permit as required by this article; or
15	(2) otherwise excepted in this article;
16	are the property of the people of Indiana.
17	(b) The department shall protect provide for the protection and

8	SECTION 4. [EFFECTIVE APRIL 1, 2016] (a) IC 14-11-4-1, as

10	March 31, 2016.
11	(b) This SECTION expires January 1, 2017.
12	SECTION 5. An emergency is declared for this act



COMMITTEE REPORT

Madam President: The Senate Committee on Natural Resources, to which was referred Senate Bill No. 195, has had the same under consideration and begs leave to report the same back to the Senate with the recommendation that said bill be AMENDED as follows:

Page 1, between the enacting clause and line 1, begin a new paragraph and insert:

"SECTION 1. IC 14-11-4-1 IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE APRIL 1, 2016]: Sec. 1. This chapter applies to applications for licenses under the following:

- (1) IC 14-22-26-3(2) (wild animals).
- (2) (1) IC 14-26-2 (lake preservation).
- (3) (2) IC 14-26-5 (dams).
- (4) (3) IC 14-28-1 (flood control).
- (5) (4) IC 14-29-3 (removal of substances from streams).
- (6) (5) IC 14-29-4 (construction of channels).".

Page 1, between lines 15 and 16, begin a new paragraph and insert: "SECTION 4. [EFFECTIVE APRIL 1, 2016] (a) IC 14-11-4-1, as amended by this act, applies to applications for licenses filed after March 31, 2016.

(b) This SECTION expires January 1, 2017.".

Renumber all SECTIONS consecutively.
