DIGEST OF SB 197 (Updated January 13, 2015 10:55 am - DI 103)

Citations Affected: IC 9-24.

Synopsis: Chauffeur's license exemption. Authorizes an individual to transport: (1) a recreational vehicle; or (2) a towing vehicle and recreational vehicle; without a chauffeur's license in certain circumstances.

Effective: July 1, 2015.

SENATE BILL No. 197

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning motor vehicles.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

1 SECTION 1. IC 9-24-4-5.3 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE
2 AS A **NEW** SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY
3 1, 2015]: **Sec. 5.3. An individual is not required to hold a**
4 **chauffeur's license in order to transport a recreational vehicle**
5 **prior to the first retail sale of the recreational vehicle if:**
6 (1) the gross weight of the recreational vehicle is not more
7 than twenty-six thousand (26,000) pounds; or
8 (2) the gross combination weight of the combination of
9 recreational vehicle and towing vehicle is not more than
10 twenty-six thousand (26,000) pounds, including a towed
11 recreational vehicle with a gross weight of not more than ten
12 thousand (10,000) pounds.
