DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: Noncode.

Synopsis: Construction of judicial building. Requires the office of management and budget (office) to prepare a preliminary engineering design and feasibility study for construction of a building or buildings on land north of the state house to house the judiciary. Appropriates money from the state general fund to the office to be used to pay costs of the study.

Effective: July 1, 2023.

SENATE BILL No. 215

A BILL FOR AN ACT concerning taxation and to make an appropriation.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

- SECTION 1. [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2023] (a) As used in this SECTION, "office" refers to the office of management and budget established by IC 4-3-22-3.
 - (b) The office shall prepare a preliminary engineering design and feasibility study for construction of a building or buildings on land north of the state house to house the judiciary and provide parking for employees and visitors to the facility, including underground secure access parking and a secure access tunnel or tunnels connecting the facility to the state house.
 - (c) The office may update and use an architectural study prepared for the budget agency under P.L.273-1999, SECTION 31 or any other study that the office considers relevant to the study required by subsection (b).
 - (d) The office may employ architects, engineers, space planners, construction managers, and any other professional persons it considers necessary to prepare the study required by subsection (b).

(e) Money is appropriated from the state general fund for the
state fiscal year beginning July 1, 2023, and ending June 30, 2024,
to the office to be used to pay costs of the study required by subsection (b).

- (f) The office shall submit the study required by subsection (b) to the legislative council in an electronic format under IC 5-14-6 before December 1, 2024.
 - (g) This SECTION expires July 1, 2025.
