DIGEST OF SB 224 (Updated January 27, 2022 1:41 pm - DI 129)

Citations Affected: IC 14-22.

Synopsis: Hunting and fishing licenses. Provides that a license agent authorized to sell licenses under the fish and wildlife laws is not prohibited from charging a credit card processing fee of 1.99% to cover credit card processing costs associated with the sale of a license.

Effective: July 1, 2022.

SENATE BILL No. 224

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning natural and cultural resources.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

1 SECTION 1. IC 14-22-12-14 IS AMENDED TO READ AS
2 FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2022]: Sec. 14. **(a) Except as**
3 **provided in subsection (b)**, a person may not directly or indirectly
4 charge, collect, or receive for a license required under this article more
5 or less than the amount specified in this article, regardless of the
6 official capacity of the person or the relationship to the licensee.
7 **(b) A license agent is not prohibited from charging a credit card**
8 **processing fee of one and ninety-nine hundredths percent (1.99%)**
9 **to cover credit card processing costs associated with the sale of a**
10 **license.**
