

SENATE BILL No. 225

DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: IC 3-11.5-4-17.

Synopsis: Deceased voters. Requires that an absentee ballot marked and forwarded by a voter who subsequently dies be counted if the absentee ballot would otherwise be entitled to be counted if the voter had not died.

Effective: July 1, 2023.

SENATE BILL No. 225

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning elections.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

1 SECTION 1. IC 3-11.5-4-17 IS AMENDED TO READ AS

 7 ~~14 of this chapter.~~ **counted if the absentee ballot would otherwise be**
 8 **entitled to be counted if the voter had not died.**
 9 (b) The casting of an absentee ballot by a deceased voter does not
 10 invalidate an election.
