## **SENATE BILL No. 232**

### DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: IC 35-44.1-2-3.

**Synopsis:** False reporting. Specifies that a law enforcement officer who, knowing that information is false or misleading, includes the false or misleading information in a police report commits false informing, a Class A misdemeanor.

Effective: July 1, 2022.

### SENATE BILL No. 232

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning criminal law and procedure.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

8	(1) the person or another person has placed or intends to place an
9	explosive, a destructive device, or other destructive substance in
0	a building or transportation facility;
1	(2) there has been or there will be tampering with a consumer
2	product introduced into commerce; or
3	(3) there has been or will be placed or introduced a weapon of
4	mass destruction in a building or a place of assembly;
5	knowing the report to be false, commits false reporting, a Level 6
6	felony.
7	(d) A person who:
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1	(1) gives (A) a false report of the commission of a crime
2	knowing the report to be false; or
3	(B) (2) gives false information to a law enforcement officer tha
4	relates to the commission of a crime, knowing the report of
5	information to be false;
6	(3) being a law enforcement officer, includes false or
7	materially misleading information in a police report, knowing
8	the information to be false or materially misleading;
9	(2) (4) gives a false alarm of fire to the fire department of a
10	governmental entity, knowing the alarm to be false;
11	(3) (5) makes a false request for ambulance service to ar
12	ambulance service provider, knowing the request to be false;
13	(4) (6) gives a false report concerning a missing child (as defined
14	in IC 10-13-5-4) or missing endangered adult (as defined in
15	IC 12-7-2-131.3) or gives false information to a law enforcement
16	officer or a governmental entity that relates to a missing child or
17	missing endangered adult knowing the report or information to be
18	false;
19	(5) (7) makes a complaint against a law enforcement officer to the
20	state or municipality (as defined in IC 8-1-13-3(b)) that employs
21	the officer:
22	(A) alleging the officer engaged in misconduct while
23	performing the officer's duties; and
24	(B) knowing the complaint to be false;
25	(6) (8) makes a false report of a missing person, knowing the
26	report or information is false;
27	(7) (9) gives a false report of actions, behavior, or conditions
28	concerning:
29	(A) a septic tank soil absorption system under IC 8-1-2-125 or
30	IC 13-26-5-2.5; or
31	(B) a septic tank soil absorption system or constructed wetland
32	septic system under IC 36-9-23-30.1;
33	knowing the report or information to be false; or
34	(8) (10) makes a false report that a person is dangerous (as
35	defined in IC 35-47-14-1) knowing the report or information to be
36	false;
37	commits false informing, a Class B misdemeanor. However, the offense
38	is a Class A misdemeanor if it is committed by a law enforcement
39	officer, if it substantially hinders any law enforcement process, or if it
40	results in harm to another person.
