DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: IC 4-20.5-6-13.

Synopsis: State house souvenir shop. Requires the Indiana department of administration to establish, maintain, and operate a souvenir shop in the state house not later than July 1, 2015.

Effective: July 1, 2014.

SENATE BILL No. 239

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning state offices and administration.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

1 SECTION 1. IC 4-20.5-6-13 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE
2 AS A **NEW** SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY
3 1, 2014]: **Sec. 13. (a) Not later than July 1, 2015, the department**
4 **shall establish, maintain, and operate a souvenir shop in the state**
5 **house.**
6 **(b) The souvenir shop established under subsection (a) shall**
7 **offer items for sale that relate to Indiana, including Indiana**
8 **government.**
9 **(c) The department may enter into appropriate contracts for the**
10 **operation of the souvenir shop established under subsection (a).**
