DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: IC 31-34-23-3.

Synopsis: Change of child placement. Requires that before changing the out-of-home placement of a child who has been in the same out-of-home placement for a period of at least one year, the department of child services must file a motion requesting a change in placement and the juvenile court shall hold a hearing on the question.
