A BILL FOR AN ACT concerning human services.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

1	SECTION 1. [EFFECTIVE UPON PASSAGE] (a) The office of
2	management and budget shall conduct a study to evaluate the
3	economic impact of drug addiction and drug use on Indiana.
4	(b) The office of management and budget shall consult with the
5	following agencies to assist in this study:
6	(1) The Indiana judicial center.
7	(2) The state department of health.
8	(3) The department of child services.
9	(4) The state police department.
10	(5) The family and social services administration.
11	(6) The state department of education.
12	(7) The department of correction.
13	(c) The office of management and budget shall prepare a report
14	concerning this study. The report must include the following
15	information:
16	(1) The amount of money and resources that Indiana state
17	agencies annually spend on drug addiction services, including
18	drug treatment and drug prevention programs.

1	(2) The amount of money that individuals and insurance
2	companies annually spend on drug treatment in Indiana.
3	(3) The amount of money that corrections programs spend on
4	drug treatment in Indiana.
5	(4) The amount of health care costs related to drug addiction
6	and drug use in Indiana.
7	(5) An analysis of the loss of production and workforce costs
8	due to drug addiction and drug use in Indiana.
9	(6) The fiscal impact of drug addiction and drug use on
10	federal assistance programs.
11	(7) The amount of money that the department of child services
12	expends on interventions due to drug addiction and drug use
13	in Indiana.
14	(8) The fiscal impact of drug addiction and drug use on local
15	units of government.
16	(9) The amount of money that local units of government spend
17	on syringe exchange programs.
18	(d) The office of management and budget may contract with an
19	outside entity to conduct the study or parts of the study.
20	(e) The office of management and budget shall submit the report
21	to the general assembly in an electronic format under IC 5-14-6
22	and to the governor by June 1, 2018.
23	(f) This SECTION expires December 31, 2019.
24	SECTION 2. An emergency is declared for this act.
