## **SENATE BILL No. 248**

DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: IC 9-28-5.1-1.

**Synopsis:** Driver's license reciprocity with Germany. Requires the bureau of motor vehicles to begin negotiating with Germany not later than July 1, 2015, a reciprocal agreement for the exchange of driver's licenses.

Effective: Upon passage.

### **SENATE BILL No. 248**

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning motor vehicles.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

1	SECTION 1. IC 9-28-5.1-1, AS AMENDED BY P.L.125-2012,
2	SECTION 307, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS
3	[EFFECTIVE UPON PASSAGE]: Sec. 1. (a) To facilitate the exchange
4	of driver's licenses, the bureau may negotiate and enter into a reciprocal
5	agreement with a foreign country. However, the bureau may not
6	negotiate or enter into a reciprocal agreement with a country that is
7	listed as a state sponsor of terrorism as determined by the Secretary of
8	State of the United States.
9	(b) Not later than July 1, 2015, the bureau shall begin to
10	negotiate with Germany a reciprocal agreement for the exchange
11	of driver's licenses under subsection (a).

12 SECTION 2. An emergency is declared for this act.
