DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: IC 21-13-12.

Synopsis: Psychiatrist student loan forgiveness program. Establishes a psychiatrist student loan forgiveness program to be used to provide student loan forgiveness payments to qualified psychiatrists who are residents of Indiana and practice psychiatric medicine in rural areas in Indiana. Provides that the commission for higher education shall, in coordination with the Indiana professional licensing agency and the medical licensing board of Indiana, administer the program. Establishes the psychiatrist student loan forgiveness program fund.

Effective: July 1, 2019.

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning higher education.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

1	SECTION 1. IC 21-13-12 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE

4	Chapter 12. Psychiatrist Student Loan Forgiveness Program
5	Sec. 1. As used in this chapter, "fund" refers to the psychiatrist
6	student loan forgiveness program fund established by section 5 of
7	this chapter.
8	Sec. 2. As used in this chapter, "program" refers to the
9	psychiatrist student loan forgiveness program established by
10	section 4 of this chapter.
11	Sec. 3. As used in this chapter, "rural area" means territory
12	within the state of Indiana that is outside the corporate limits of a
13	city or town.
14	Sec. 4. (a) The psychiatrist student loan forgiveness program is
15	established.
16	(b) The commission shall, in coordination with the Indiana
17	professional licensing agency and the medical licensing board of



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1 Indiana created by IC 25-22.5-2-1, administer the program. 2 Sec. 5. (a) The psychiatrist student loan forgiveness program 3 fund is established for the purpose of encouraging and promoting 4 qualified psychiatrists to practice psychiatric medicine in rural 5 areas in Indiana. 6 (b) The fund consists of the following: 7 (1) Appropriations by the general assembly. 8 (2) Gifts to the fund. 9 (c) The commission shall administer the fund. 10 (d) The expenses of administering the fund shall be paid from 11 money in the fund. 12 (e) The treasurer of state shall invest the money in the fund not 13 currently needed to meet the obligations of the fund in the same 14 manner as other public money may be invested. Interest that 15 accrues from these investments shall be deposited in the fund. 16 (f) Money in the fund at the end of a fiscal year does not revert 17 to the state general fund. 18 Sec. 6. (a) The money in the fund must be used to provide 19 annual student loan forgiveness payments to psychiatrists who 20 meet the requirements under section 7 of this chapter. 21 (b) Subject to subsection (d) and section 8 of this chapter, for a 22 psychiatrist who conducts the minimum percentage amount 23 established under subsection (e) or more of the psychiatrist's 24 psychiatric medical practice in a rural area of Indiana, a student 25 loan forgiveness payment awarded under this chapter in a 26 particular year is equal to the lesser of the following: 27 (1) The balance of the psychiatrist's total amount of student 28 loans. 29 (2) Twenty thousand dollars (\$20,000). 30 (c) Subject to subsection (d) and section 8 of this chapter, for a 31 psychiatrist who conducts at least half but less than the minimum 32 percentage amount established under subsection (e) of the 33 psychiatrist's psychiatric medical practice in a rural area of 34 Indiana, a student loan forgiveness payment awarded under this 35 chapter in a particular year is equal to the lesser of the following: 36 (1) The balance of the psychiatrist's total amount of student 37 loans. 38 (2) Ten thousand dollars (\$10,000). 39 (d) The commission may award each year, for not more than 40 five (5) years, a student loan forgiveness payment to a psychiatrist 41 who meets the requirements under section 7 of this chapter. 42 (e) The commission shall establish a minimum percentage



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1	amount of a psychiatrist's psychiatric medical practice that the
2	psychiatrist must practice in a rural area of Indiana to be eligible
3	for a student loan forgiveness payment under subsection (b).
4	Sec. 7. To qualify for a student loan forgiveness payment from
5	the fund, an individual must:
6	(1) be a resident of Indiana;
7	(2) be licensed as a physician under IC 25-22.5;
8	(3) practice psychiatric medicine;
9	(4) conduct:
10	(A) the minimum percentage amount established under
11	section 6(e) of this chapter or more of the individual's
12	psychiatric medical practice in a rural area in Indiana to
13	receive a student loan forgiveness payment under section
14	6(b) of this chapter; or
15	(B) at least half but less than the minimum percentage
16	amount established under section 6(e) of this chapter of the
17	individual's psychiatric medical practice in a rural area in
18	Indiana to receive a student loan forgiveness payment
19	under section 6(c) of this chapter;
20	(5) have an outstanding student loan balance at the beginning
21	of the calendar year; and
22	(6) be approved by the commission.
23	Sec. 8. If the total amount to be distributed from the fund in a
24	state fiscal year exceeds the amount available for distribution, the
25	amount to be distributed to each eligible psychiatrist shall be
26	proportionately reduced so that the total reductions equal the
27	amount of the excess.
28	Sec. 9. Each psychiatrist who:
29	(1) applies under this chapter; and
30	(2) is approved under this chapter;
31	shall provide to the commission any information that the
32	commission determines is necessary to administer this chapter.
33	Sec. 10. The commission may adopt rules under IC 4-22-2 that
34	are necessary to implement this chapter.
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
