# **SENATE BILL No. 253**

#### DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: IC 5-2-1-19.

**Synopsis:** Northwest Indiana law enforcement academy. Designates the northwest Indiana law enforcement academy as a criminal justice agency, and specifies that it is a board certified training center. Defines the powers and duties of the board.

Effective: July 1, 2014.

### SENATE BILL No. 253

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning public safety.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

SECTION 1. IC 5-2-1-19 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE

2	AS A <b>NEW</b> SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY
3	1, 2014]: Sec. 19. (a) The northwest Indiana law enforcement
4	academy, including the academy's board of directors, is designated
5	as a criminal justice agency.
6	(b) The northwest Indiana law enforcement academy is a board
7	certified training center.
8	(c) As a designated criminal justice agency, the board of
9	directors of the northwest Indiana law enforcement academy:
10	(1) has all the duties and privileges of a police agency;
11	(2) may appoint, through its executive director, police officers
12	for the northwest Indiana law enforcement academy;
13	(3) shall establish all rules, policies, and procedures
14	concerning the internal organization, duties, and
15	responsibilities of the police agency, to include:
16	(A) prescribing a distinctive uniform; and
