DIGEST OF SB 256 (Updated March 20, 2017 1:08 pm - DI 109)

Citations Affected: IC 14-12; IC 14-13.

Synopsis: Benjamin Harrison conservation trust. Makes nonvoting members of the Indiana Heritage Trust project committee voting members. Makes conforming changes. Makes nonvoting members of the Indiana White River State Park Development Commission voting members. Makes conforming changes.

Effective: July 1, 2017.

ENGROSSED SENATE BILL No. 256

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning natural and cultural resources.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

1	SECTION 1. IC 14-12-2-14, AS AMENDED BY P.L.172-2016,
2	SECTION 16, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
3	JULY 1, 2017]: Sec. 14. (a) The President Benjamin Harrison
4	conservation trust project committee is established.
5	(b) The project committee consists of the following twenty-one (21)
6	members:
7	(1) The director of the division of fish and wildlife.
8	(2) The director of the division of forestry.
9	(3) The director of the division of nature preserves.
10	(4) The director of the division of state parks.
11	(5) The director of the division of outdoor recreation.
12	(6) The chief executive officer of the Indiana state museum and
13	historic sites corporation established by IC 4-37-2-1.
14	(7) The chairperson of the board of directors of the natural
15	resources foundation.
16	(8) Ten (10) individuals appointed by the governor. The governor
17	shall appoint individuals so that all the following are satisfied:



1	(A) The individuals must be residents of Indiana.
2	(B) The individuals must have a demonstrated interest or
3 4	experience in:
	(i) conservation of natural resources; or
5	(ii) management of public property.
6	(C) There must be two (2) committee members from each of
7	the following regions of Indiana:
8	(i) Northwest.
9	(ii) Northeast.
10	(iii) Southwest.
11	(iv) Southeast.
12	(v) Central.
13	(9) The following four (4) nonvoting members:
14	(A) One (1) member of the house of representatives appointed
15	by the speaker of the house of representatives.
16	(B) One (1) member of the house of representatives appointed
17	by the minority leader of the house of representatives.
18	(C) One (1) member of the senate appointed by the president
19	pro tempore of the senate.
20	(D) One (1) member of the senate appointed by the minority
21	leader of the senate.
22	(c) The individuals appointed by the governor under subsection
23	(b)(8) must represent one (1) or more of the following:
24	(1) The environmentalist community.
25	(2) The land trust community.
26	(3) Organized hunting and fishing groups.
27	(4) The forest products community.
28	(5) The parks and recreation community.
29	Each group and community listed in subdivisions (1) through (5) must
30	be represented on the project committee.
31	SECTION 2. IC 14-12-2-18, AS AMENDED BY P.L.172-2016,
32	SECTION 19, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
33	JULY 1, 2017]: Sec. 18. (a) Nine (9) One half (1/2) plus one (1) of the
34	appointed members of the project committee constitute a quorum.
35	(b) The affirmative vote of a majority of the voting members of the
36	project committee present and voting is necessary for the project
37	committee to take any action.
38	(c) A member of the project committee described in section $14(b)(1)$
39	through 14(b)(6) of this chapter may designate in writing a
40	representative from the respective division to serve as a member of the
41	project committee when the member of the project committee is unable
42	to attend a meeting.

COMMITTEE REPORT

Mr. Speaker: Your Committee on Natural Resources, to which was referred Senate Bill 256, has had the same under consideration and begs leave to report the same back to the House with the recommendation that said bill be amended as follows:

Page 2, line33, after "the" insert "appointed".

Page 2, after line 42, begin a new paragraph and insert:

"SECTION 3. IC 14-13-1-6 IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2017]: Sec. 6. (a) The commission has ten (10) fourteen (14) voting members as follows:

(1) The director or the director's designee.

(2) The executive of the city of Indianapolis or the executive's designee.

(3) The president of Indiana University or the president's designee.

(4) Seven (7) members appointed by the governor as follows:

(A) One (1) member for a term ending December 31, 1995.

(B) Two (2) members for terms ending December 31, 1996.

(C) Two (2) members for terms ending December 31, 1997.

(D) Two (2) members for terms ending December 31, 1998.

(5) Four (4) legislative members appointed by the governor from the recommendations made by the speaker of the house of representatives and the president pro tempore of the senate as follows:

(A) Two (2) legislative members must be members of the house of representatives, but may not be members of the same political party.

(B) Two (2) legislative members must be members of the senate, but may not be members of the same political



party.

(b) The term of a legislative member is four (4) years, except for the following:

(1) A legislative member's membership on the commission is terminated when the legislative member ceases to be a member of the general assembly.

(2) A legislative member appointed to serve an unexpired term may serve only until the end of that term.

SECTION 4. IC 14-13-1-7 IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2017]: Sec. 7. The term of a voting member who is not a member of the general assembly is four (4) years. However, if an appointee is appointed to serve an unexpired term, the appointee serves only until the end of the unexpired term.

SECTION 5. IC 14-13-1-9 IS REPEALED [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2017]. Sec. 9. (a) In addition to the voting members of the commission, the governor shall appoint four (4) legislative members from the general assembly from recommendations made by the speaker of the house of representatives and the president pro tempore of the senate as follows:

(1) Two (2) legislative members must be members of the house of representatives, but may not be members of the same political party.

(2) Two (2) legislative members must be members of the senate, but may not be members of the same political party.

(b) The legislative members may not:

(1) vote in proceedings of the commission; and

(2) be counted for purposes of establishing a quorum.

(c) The term of a legislative member is four (4) years, except for the following:

(1) A legislative member's membership on the commission is terminated when the legislative member ceases to be a member of the general assembly.

(2) A legislative member appointed to serve an unexpired term may serve only until the end of that term.

SECTION 6. IC 14-13-1-11 IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2017]: Sec. 11. (a) The governor shall annually designate:

(1) one (1) of the voting members of the commission as chairman; and

(2) one (1) of the voting members of the commission as treasurer; for terms expiring December 31.

(b) A member designated under subsection (a)(1) or (a)(2) may



not be a member of the general assembly.

SECTION 7. IC 14-13-1-12 IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2017]: Sec. 12. (a) The commission shall meet on call of any of the following:

(1) The chairman.

(2) The executive director.

(3) Any three (3) voting five (5) members.

(b) Seven (7) voting One half (1/2) plus one (1) of the appointed members of the commission constitute a quorum.

SECTION 8. IC 14-13-1-13 IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2017]: Sec. 13. (a) Each voting member who is not a member of the general assembly, is entitled to reimbursement for traveling and other expenses as provided in the state travel policies and procedures established by the Indiana department of administration and approved by the budget agency. Each voting member who is not a state employee is entitled to the minimum salary per diem as provided in IC 4-10-11-2.1(b).

(b) Each legislative member of the commission is entitled to receive the same per diem, mileage, and travel allowances paid to members of the general assembly serving on interim study committees established by the legislative council.".

and when so amended that said bill do pass.
