# ENGROSSED SENATE BILL No. 257

---

DIGEST OF SB 257 (Updated February 20, 2018 5:24 pm - DI 113)

**Citations Affected:** IC 6-2.5; noncode.

**Synopsis:** Sales tax on software. Provides that for purposes of the sales tax, a person is a retail merchant making a retail transaction when the person sells, rents, leases, licenses for consideration the right to use prewritten computer software delivered electronically. Specifies, however, that a transaction in which a user purchases, rents, leases, or licenses the right to remotely access prewritten computer software: (1) is not considered to be a transaction in which prewritten computer software is delivered electronically; and (2) does not constitute a retail transaction (and is therefore not subject to sales tax).

**Effective:** July 1, 2018.

## ENGROSSED SENATE BILL No. 257

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning taxation.

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:*

1 SECTION 1. IC 6-2.5-4-16.7 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA  
2 CODE AS A **NEW** SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS  
3 [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2018]: **Sec. 16.7. (a) Except as provided in**  
4 **subsection (b), a person is a retail merchant making a retail**  
5 **transaction when the person sells, rents, leases, or licenses for**  
6 **consideration the right to use prewritten computer software**  
7 **delivered electronically.**  
8 **(b) A transaction in which an end user purchases, rents, leases,**  
9 **or licenses the right to remotely access prewritten computer**  
10 **software over the Internet, over private or public networks, or**  
11 **through wireless media:**  
12 **(1) is not considered to be a transaction in which prewritten**  
13 **computer software is delivered electronically; and**  
14 **(2) does not constitute a retail transaction.**  
15 SECTION 2. [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2018] **(a) IC 6-2.5-4-16.7, as**  
16 **added by this act, applies only to transactions occurring after June**  
17 **30, 2018.**
