A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning courts and court officers.

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:*

1 SECTION 1. IC 33-42-8-1 IS AMENDED TO READ AS  
2 FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2017]: Sec. 1. The maximum fee  
3 of a notary public is ~~two ten~~ dollars (~~\$2~~) (**\$10**) for each notarial act.
