DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: Noncode.

Synopsis: Broadband capacity infrastructure study. Urges the legislative council to assign to the interim study committee on energy, utilities, and telecommunications (committee) the topic of the installation and leasing of broadband capacity infrastructure by investor owned electric utilities to broadband service providers for the provision of broadband Internet service to unserved and underserved areas in Indiana. Provides that if a study is assigned to the committee: (1) the committee must consider certain specified issues; and (2) an electric utility may submit to the committee, not later than July 1, 2021, a study concerning the feasibility of making available broadband capacity infrastructure for use by broadband service providers in providing broadband service in unserved or underserved areas in the electric utility's assigned service area.

A BILL FOR AN ACT concerning utilities.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

1	SECTION 1. [EFFECTIVE UPON PASSAGE] (a) As used in this
2	SECTION, "commission" refers to the Indiana utility regulatory
3	commission created by IC 8-1-1-2.
4	(b) As used in this SECTION, "committee" refers to the interim
5	study committee on energy, utilities, and telecommunications
6	established by IC 2-5-1.3-4(8).
7	(c) As used in this SECTION, "electric utility" means a public
8	utility (as defined in IC 8-1-2-1(a)) that:
9	(1) is an investor owned utility;
10	(2) provides retail electric service to Indiana customers; and
11	(3) is under the jurisdiction of the commission for the
12	approval of rates and charges.
13	(d) As used in this SECTION, "unserved or underserved area"
14	refers to an area in Indiana in which broadband Internet service
15	is not available to all potential customers in the area.
16	(e) The legislative council is urged to assign to the committee the
17	task of studying, during the 2021 legislative interim, the installing

- (1) Whether facilitating the deployment of broadband Internet service to areas of Indiana that are unserved or underserved is in the public interest.
- (2) The capability of electric utilities to support the deployment of broadband Internet service to unserved and underserved areas in Indiana.
- (3) The rules and regulations that would be appropriate to provide for leasing of broadband capacity infrastructure to broadband service providers, including preclusion of electric utilities from offering broadband services to retail customers in Indiana.
- (4) The potential to establish a broadband capacity infrastructure leasing pilot program that would support the deployment of broadband Internet service to unserved and underserved areas in Indiana.
- (f) If a study is assigned to the committee under this SECTION, an electric utility may submit to the committee a study concerning the feasibility of making available broadband capacity infrastructure for use by broadband service providers in providing broadband service in unserved or underserved areas in the electric utility's assigned service area. A report that an electric utility elects to submit under this subsection must be submitted in an electronic format under IC 5-14-6 not later than July 1, 2021, to the executive director of the legislative services agency for distribution to members of the committee.
- (g) This SECTION expires January 1, 2022. SECTION 2. An emergency is declared for this act.
