SENATE ENROLLED ACT No. 271

AN ACT concerning natural resources.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

SECTION 1. [EFFECTIVE APRIL 1, 2014] (a) The general assembly urges the legislative council to assign to the appropriate committee the following responsibilities for the 2014 legislative interim:

- (1) Receive testimony and information from the Indiana utility regulatory commission created by IC 8-1-1-2 concerning the findings presented by the commission in its most recent report to the legislative council under IC 8-1-30.5-3(c)(1).
- (2) Receive testimony on the effect that the relative availability of water resources has upon state and regional economic development decisions.
- (3) Receive testimony concerning ways in which state government agencies could better coordinate their activities relating to the management of water resources.
- (4) Receive testimony concerning ways in which state and local governments can better coordinate their activities relating to the management of water resources.
- (5) Receive testimony concerning the unique water resource challenges facing rural Indiana and, in particular, the agricultural community, including aquifer withdrawals, surface water concerns, and inter-basin transfers.



- (6) Receive testimony that evaluates:
 - (A) the recommendations set forth by the Indiana utility regulatory commission in its most recent report to the legislative council under IC 8-1-30.5-3(c)(1); and
 - (B) other recommendations concerning Indiana's water resources.
- (7) Receive testimony on the key elements that a state water plan should contain.
- (8) Study the potential creation of a water institute.
- (9) Study the potential creation of a water management authority.
- (b) This SECTION expires December 31, 2014. SECTION 2. An emergency is declared for this act.
