ENGROSSED SENATE BILL No. 275

DIGEST OF SB 275 (Updated March 15, 2017 10:56 am - DI 84)

Citations Affected: IC 9-24.

Synopsis: Nondomiciled commercial driver's licenses. Requires the bureau of motor vehicles to issue nondomiciled commercial driver's licenses in accordance with federal regulations after December 31, 2017. Requires an individual who applies for a nondomiciled commercial drivers license to submit a proper application under IC 9-24.

Effective: July 1, 2017.

ENGROSSED SENATE BILL No. 275

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning motor vehicles.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

- 1 SECTION 1. IC 9-24-6.1-10 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE
2 AS A NEW SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY
3 1, 2017]: **Sec. 10. (a) As used in this section, "nondomiciled
4 commercial driver's license" means a commercial driver's license
5 that is issued to an individual who is domiciled:**
6 (1) in a foreign country meeting the requirements of 49 CFR
7 383.23(b)(1); or
8 (2) in another state meeting the requirements of 49 CFR
9 383.23(b)(2).
10 (b) After December 31, 2017, the bureau shall issue a
11 nondomiciled commercial driver's license in accordance with 49
12 CFR 383.23 to an individual who:
13 (1) submits a proper application under this article; and
14 (2) meets the requirements of 49 CFR 383.71(f).
15 (c) The bureau may create an application form or other
16 required documents to implement this section.
17 (d) The fee for a nondomiciled commercial driver's license is the

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1 same as for a commercial driver's license under section 4 of this
2 chapter.

3 (e) A nondomiciled commercial driver's license is subject to the
4 same restrictions and requirements as a commercial driver's
5 license under this chapter.

6 (f) The bureau may adopt rules under IC 4-22-2 to implement
7 this section.
