DIGEST OF SB 276 (Updated January 29, 2014 8:39 pm - DI 71)

Citations Affected: IC 20-30.

Synopsis: Music courses in school curriculum. Requires each school corporation to offer music classes, including music ensembles, as part of the school corporation's curriculum.

Effective: July 1, 2014.

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning education.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

1	SECTION 1. IC 20-30-5-7, AS AMENDED BY P.L.86-2007,
2	SECTION 1, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE

2	(4) Sciences.

3	(5) Fine arts, including music and art and music, including

7	(7) Additional studies selected by each governing body, subject
8	to revision by the state board.
