DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: IC 9-18.1-14-11; IC 14-16-1-33.

Synopsis: Child safety requirements for off-road vehicles. Provides that an individual less than 18 years of age is not required to wear a helmet while operating or riding on an off-road vehicle if the child is properly fastened and restrained by a child restraint system designed to protect the child's head. Provides that a person may not knowingly authorize or permit an individual less than 18 years of age to operate or ride on an off-road vehicle in violation of the statute providing helmet requirements for off-road vehicle operators.

Effective: July 1, 2024.
