DIGEST OF SB 286 (Updated January 22, 2018 12:18 pm - DI 55)

Citations Affected: Noncode.

Synopsis: SPEA study of Indiana environmental policy. Requires the Indiana University School of Public and Environmental Affairs (SPEA) to assess the potential for development of low-carbon and green industries in Indiana and the job creation, economic growth, and wealth generation that could result for Indiana communities from the development of these industries. Requires SPEA to report the results of its assessment to the legislative council not later than December 1, 2018.

Effective: Upon passage.

SENATE BILL No. 286

A BILL FOR AN ACT concerning environmental law.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

- 1 SECTION 1. [EFFECTIVE UPON PASSAGE] (a) **The Indiana**
2 **University School of Public and Environmental Affairs shall assess:**
3 **(1) the potential for development of low-carbon and green**
4 **industries in Indiana; and**
5 **(2) the job creation, economic growth, and wealth generation**
6 **for Indiana communities that could result from the**
7 **development of low-carbon and green industries.**
8 **(b) The Indiana University School of Public and Environmental**
9 **Affairs shall present to the legislative council a report setting forth**
10 **the results of the assessment required by subsection (a) not later**
11 **than December 1, 2018.**
12 **(c) This SECTION expires December 31, 2018.**
13 SECTION 2. **An emergency is declared for this act.**
