DIGEST OF SB 290 (Updated January 29, 2014 2:50 pm - DI 106)

Citations Affected: Noncode.

Synopsis: Medical debt collection procedures. Urges the legislative council to assign the topic of medical debt collection in small claims courts to an interim study committee.

Effective: July 1, 2014.

A BILL FOR AN ACT concerning civil procedure.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

SECTION 1. [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2014] (a) As used in	n this
SECTION, "commission" refers to the commission on o	courts
established by IC 33-23-10-1.	

- (b) The general assembly urges the legislative council to assign to the commission or another appropriate study committee the task of studying medical debt collection in small claims courts.
- (c) If the commission or another appropriate committee is assigned the topic described in subsection (b), the commission or committee shall issue to the legislative council a final report containing the commission's or committee's findings and recommendations, including any recommended legislation concerning the topic, in an electronic format under IC 5-14-6 not later than November 1, 2014.
 - (d) This SECTION expires January 1, 2015.
