## **SENATE BILL No. 294**

DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: IC 16-42-19-30; IC 25-26-13-33.

**Synopsis:** Legend drug investigations. Provides that certain laws concerning obtaining a legend drug or the validity of a prescription or drug order do not apply to actions of a person, practitioner, or pharmaceutical manufacturer performed in an investigation of a pharmaceutical manufacturer's legend drug that is suspected of being counterfeited, adulterated, or misbranded. Prohibits a person from owning or operating a store, facility, or other place of business in Indiana where: (1) prescriptions are accepted to be filled; or (2) prescription drugs or devices are ordered, offered or advertised for sale, or paid for; unless the person has a pharmacy permit. Excludes mail order and Internet based pharmacies to the extent that they are allowed to operate under state law.

Effective: July 1, 2015.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:
